## **AMENDMENTS TO THE PUBLIC PROCUREMENT, UTILITIES AND CONCESSION CONTRACTS REGULATIONS**

Further to Contracts Circular N° 13/2021, the consolidated versions of the Public Procurement Regulations S.L. 601.03, Utilities<sup>1</sup> Procurement Regulations S.L. 601.05, and the Concession Contracts Regulations S.L. 601.09 incorporate amendments as per Legal Notice 26 of 2022 which came into force on 28 January 2022.
